## DISHWASHING - 3 sink method

## For Multiservice Articles



## *SANITIZE using hot water:

- Dishes must be immersed in hot water $\left(77^{\circ} \mathrm{C}\right)$ for 45 seconds



## *SANITIZE using chemical sanitizers:

- Water temperature for chemical sanitizing must be $24^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$ ( $75^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ ).
- Sanitize for 45 seconds.
- NEVER mix chemicals. Combining chemicals is toxic

Use one of the following chemical sanitizers, and measure it correctly!

- Chlorine ("bleach"): 100ppm (1 oz. Per gallon of water
- Iodine: 25ppm (0.25 oz per gallon of water
- Quaternary Ammonium ("Quats"): 200 ppm (2 oz. Per gallon of water)
