

Goal of activity: Children exposed to violence often have difficulty with cooperative play and reciprocity in relationships. This activity will allow children to engage in a cooperative activity with peers.

Approximate length of activity: 10 – 15 minutes

Materials: Large pictures placed cardstock or poster board and cut into 2-3 pieces to create a puzzle.

Instructional Procedures:

- The teacher/aide will cut pictures into 2-3 different pieces.
- The teacher/aide will demonstrate putting a puzzle together by showing children several puzzle pieces and allowing children to guess aloud which piece will fit.
- The teacher/aide will explain that the students will be working together to make a picture with their own puzzle pieces.
- The teacher/aide will pass out one puzzle piece to each child.
- The children will be instructed to find the other person who has the other half of their puzzle.
- Each pair or groups will show and tell the other students the picture they made.
