

GSRP Over Income Sliding Scale Tuition Agreement

Up to 15% of children enrolled throughout the Intermediate School District (ISD) may be from families above 250% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) with extreme risk for low educational achievement as determined by the number or severity of GSRP program eligibility factors. These families must be charged tuition calculated on a sliding scale, based on family income, and determined to be a reasonable amount a family should pay toward the cost of GSRP.

Your family's income is over 250% of the Federal Poverty Level, therefore tuition must be paid in full for your child to participate in an NMCAA GSRP classroom. This is an agreement that you will pay either in cash or a check made out to NMCAA, in the amount of \$_____.

Tuition amounts are determined by the sliding scale from the ISD in which the GSRP program is located.
